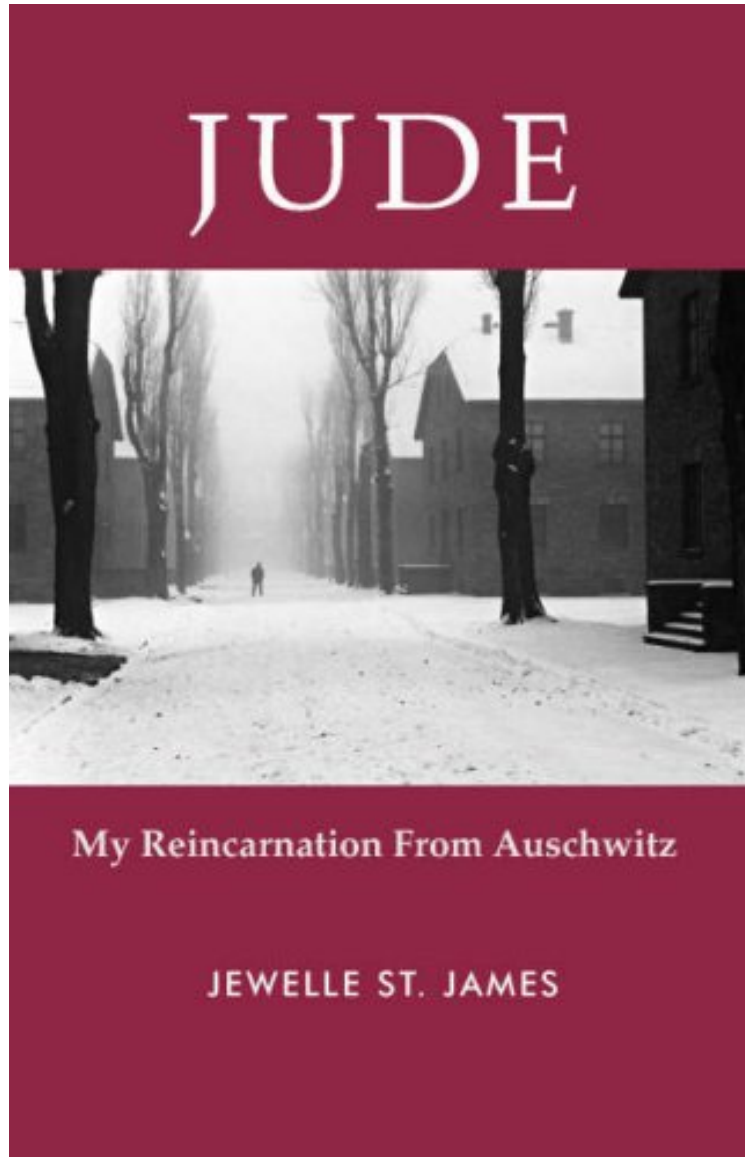

Healing from a life that ended in the death camps is not easy, but living with the unresolved aftermath is worse.
