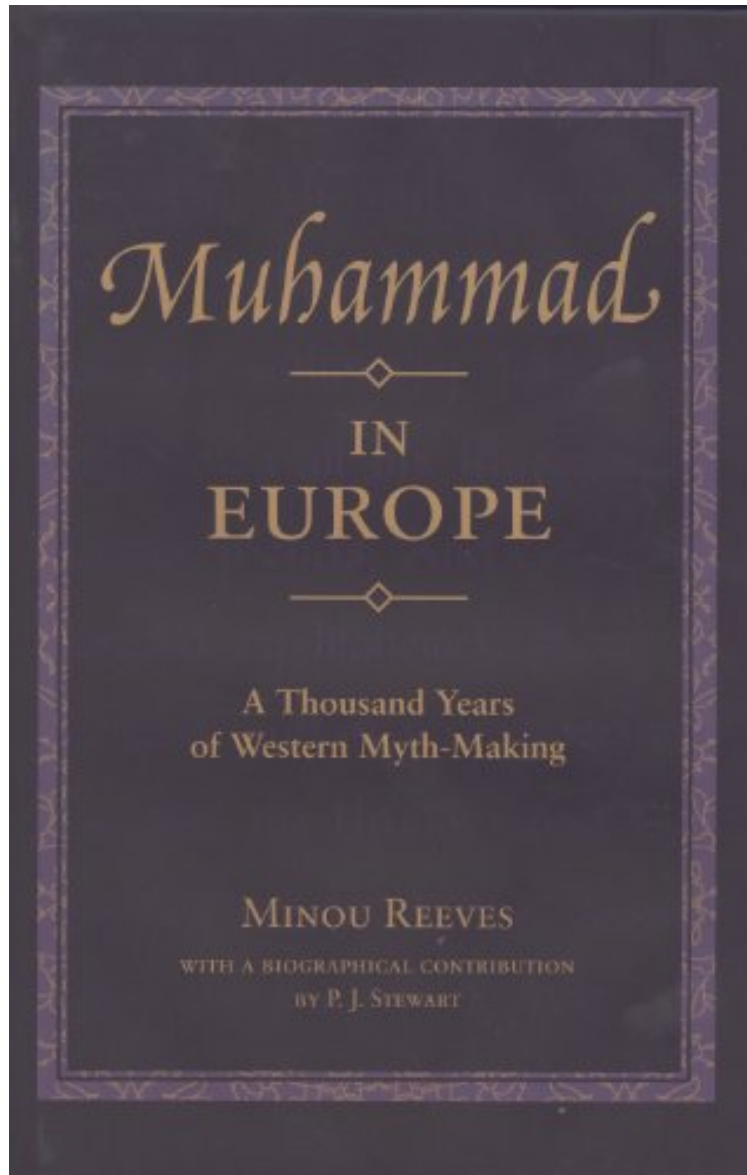


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Muhammad in Europe: A Thousand Years of Western Myth-Making
