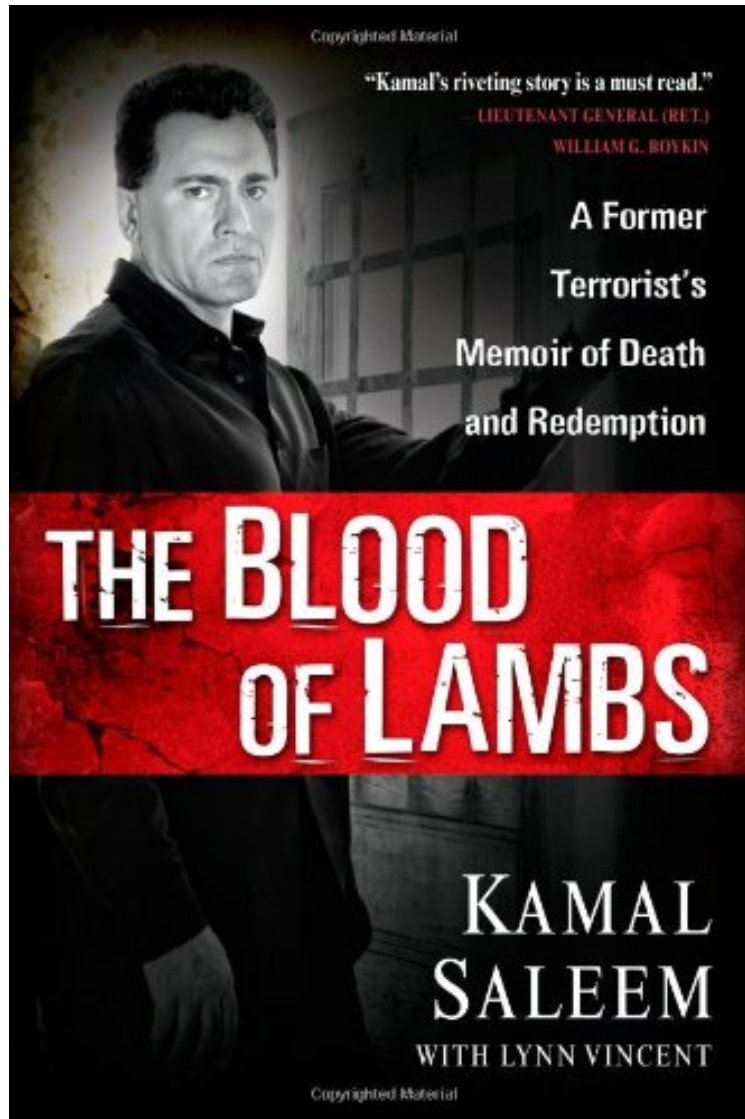

At the age of seven he was introduced to the Muslim Brotherhood and started on the path of Islamic terrorism. As an adult he came to the U. S. to further jihad against the West. But after a terrible auto accident he was befriended by Christians who showed him the love of their God. In desperation he prayed to Allah who was silent. He then prayed to the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, and Jesus revealed Himself to Kamal. He has been on fire for the Lord ever since and gave up his life of jihad. It is a moving testimony of redemption and salvation.
