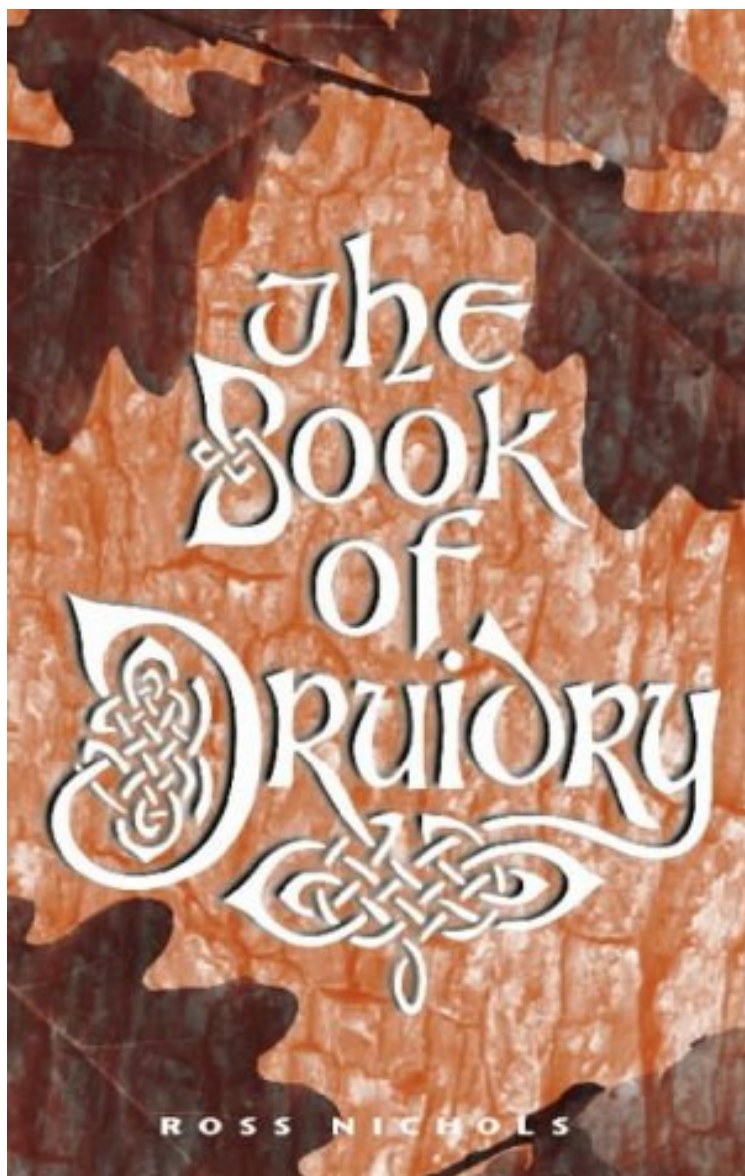

He goes into important authors, former chief Druids of OBOD, important trees, mythology. solar and agricultural celebrations,

important monolith circles and more. This man is extremely knowledgeable. When explaining culture he compares and contrasts with Egyptian, Indian and more. I found myself having to reread certain passages to understand what he was saying. I wouldn't describe this as light reading. His measurements and insights into Stonehenge are overwhelming. Mr. Nichols does use the word "probably" frequently to string together some assumptions. I'm not knowledgeable enough to critique him but this book seems to be relevant three decades after his death. Many thanks to John Matthews and Phillip Carr-Gomm for pulling together Ross Nichols manuscripts, hand-written notes and whatever to assemble this book. This book is probably as important to the foundation of Druidism as 'Witchcraft Today' by Gerald Gardner is to Wicca.
