He advocates a return to basic Conservative principles regarding such areas as family values, marriage, same-sex marriage and abortion on which he has questioned the morality of granting human rights to great apes while at the same time denying the rights of unborn children. There are Conservative governments now in power in the USA, Great Britain and Germany and countries such as France, Holland and Sweden are all beginning to field strong Conservative political parties some of whom are poised in preparation to gain power and by contrast Cory Bernardi considers that the conservative Liberal Party of Australia has lost its way and is beginning to drift to the Left in such areas as immigration, same-sex marriage and family values. An answer to this is to form his own Australian Conservatives Party.
