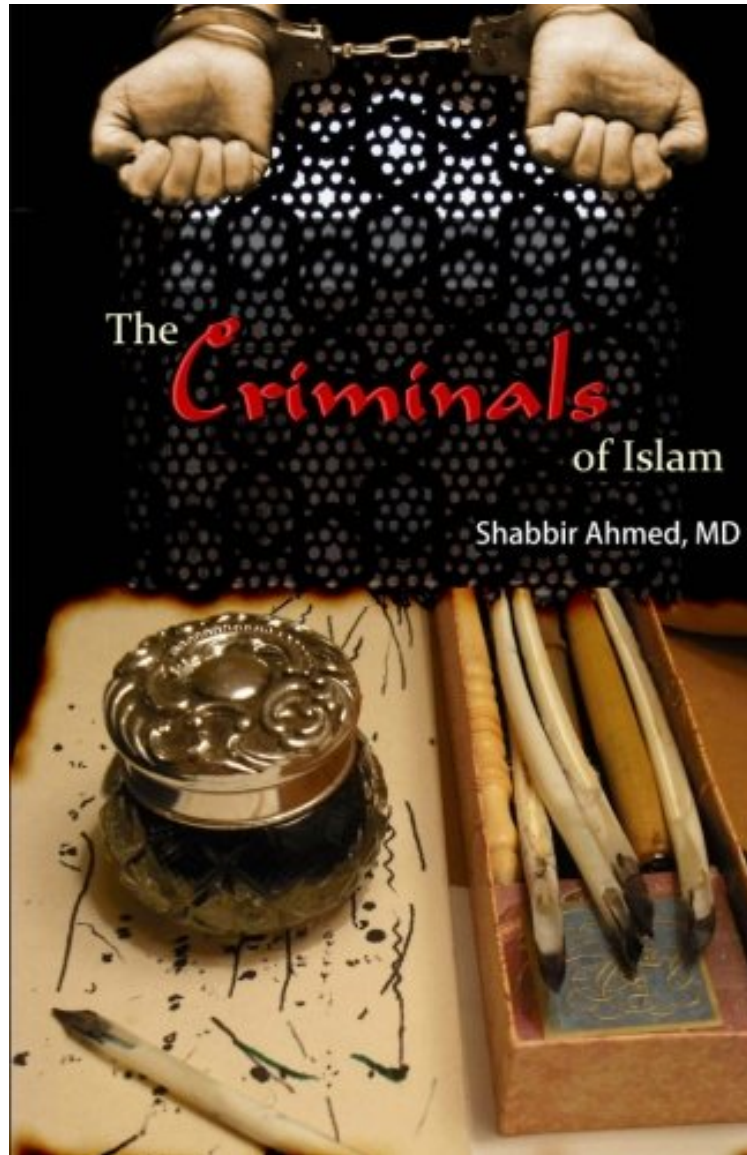

A prolific writer, he has authored numerous books and articles on Islam and history, in both English and Urdu languages.
